



The Bank of Scotland (BOS) and the Royal Bank of Scotland (RBS) released a new polymer GBP 50 (pound) note this summer. The colour of the BOS banknote has changed from green to red; the design of the face and back has also been altered. The Flora Stevenson note is the first Scotish GBP50 note issued by the Royal Bank of Scotland to commemorate a female historic figure. Both banknotes feature a large transparent window with a Kinegram Colors® foil stripe in the middle.
