People's Bank of China issued two CNY 20 (yuan) notes on 21 December 2021 to commemorate the 24th Beijing Winter Olympics (held between 4 and 20 February 2022). The notes measure 70mm by 145mm; one has ice sports as its theme and is made of polymer, the other features a skier, is themed to winter sports, and printed on paper. Both notes feature a red commemorative logo on the face (a stylized skier, the text 'BEIJING 2022' as well as the Olympic rings). A total of 200 million sets were made of which 40,000 in a special presentation folder.
